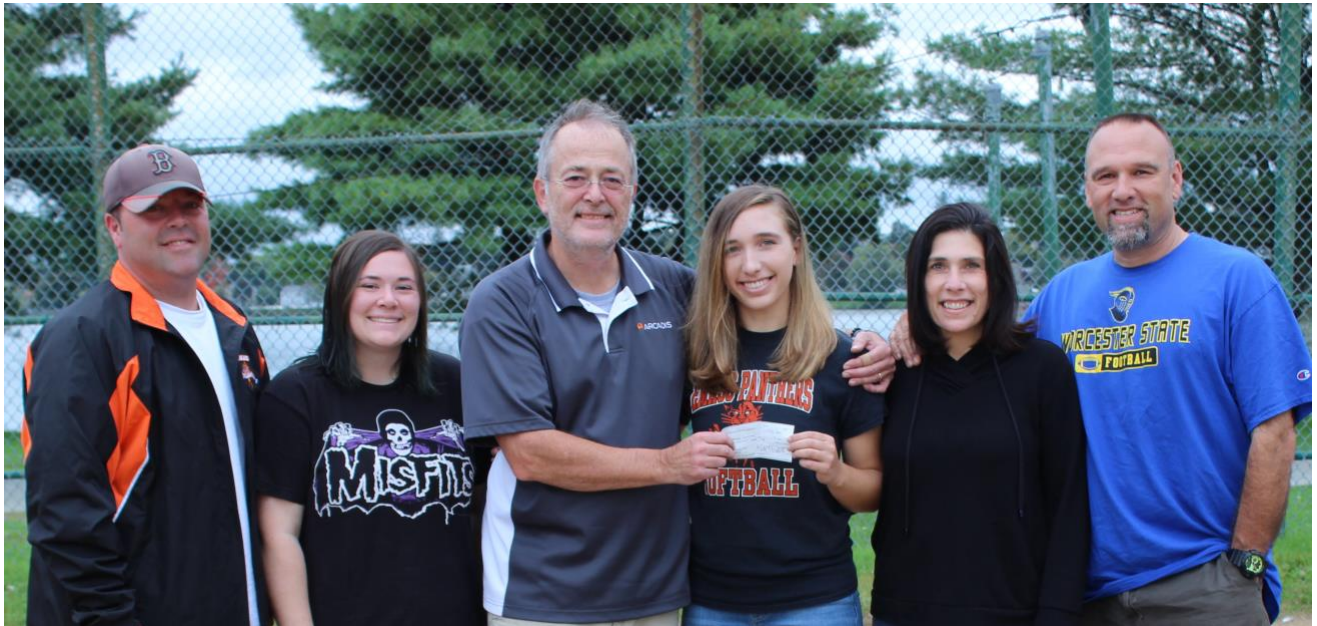




THE MEGHAN BURNETT FOUNDATION

The Meghan Burnett Foundation is pleased to announce an annual \$500-\$1,000 scholarship award that will be given as part of the Meghan Burnett Fly High tournament. All graduating seniors who participate in the Tournament are invited to apply for this award whether they played in the tournament, in a band at the tournament or volunteered to help. The award is presented to the applicant who demonstrates the highest levels of Commitment, Leadership, Enthusiasm and Love for the game (or band or whatever organization they are affiliated with)



Last years award went to Brooke Lamothe, a 2018 graduate of Tewksbury Memorial High School who is enrolled at Worcester State University.

To be considered for the award, applicants must have committed to a college (don't have to be playing ball there), send us a short essay (less than 1 page, quality not quantity), include their contact info, email and cell phone number where they can be reached and tell us how they believe they meet the aforementioned qualifications. Also provide a short recommendation from a non-related supervising adult (coach, teacher, employer) who can attest to the character of the applicant and why they are recommending this individual. The +/- 18 year-old applicant isn't always comfortable speaking up for themselves, that's why the recommendation is important.

Email the essay and recommendation together to MeghanBurnettFoundation@gmail.com with "Scholarship" in the subject line. Applications are due by midnight on June 1, No exceptions. Winner will be notified before the tournament and announced preceding the final game at Veterans Field on Sunday. In the event of a tie, both applicants will be awarded \$500.
