## Check In

Teams are required to check in at least 1 hour prior to your first scheduled game. You must present a copy of the following to the Tournament Director: - Official ASA Roster

- Birth Certificates or Player ID Cards
- Proof of insurance


## Infield Practice

We have a small practice field at the back of the complex to be shared for all teams prior to their first game of the tournament. Please keep it down to approx. 10-15 minutes to allow everyone to have an opportunity. Portable hitting nets may be used, but away from all game areas, preferably toward back of complex by practice field (not on game fields).

## Jewelry \& Helmets

No jewelry is allowed during this tournament. Jewelry can not be taped over. Medical bracelets may be worn, but must be taped to the body. Players must wear approved helmets and face guards with chin straps.

## Game Format

This tournament is 3 pool play games into a single elimination. Home team will be determined by a double coin flip during pool play. limit will be one hour and thirty minutes (1:30), no new inning will start after this point. Pool play games can end in a tie. Sunday games will also be no new inning after one hour and thirty minutes ( $1: 30$ ), the tiebreaker rule will be used if the score is tied after 7 innings or is tied after the time limit regardless of inning.
Lineups are to be handed to the official scorer no later than 10 minutes prior to the start of the game. The game clock will start at the conclusion of ground rules. Higher seed will have choice on Sunday. ASA rules apply with the exception of slashing. Slashing is prohibited. Should there be an attempt to slash, the batter will be called out.

## Draw

This tournament will begin on Friday night. Please understand, every effort will be made to accommodate you if there is a hardship on playing Friday. Request will be handled on a first come first serve basis. Further away teams will be given more consideration.

## Weather Issues

At any time during the tournament with the unanimous agreement of the Tournament Director and the UIC, abbreviated procedures may be initiated to allow the tournament to continue to completion. This includes reducing game times to 1 hour, reducing games to five innings, and/or reducing pool play. Teams are asked to provide the director with a cell phone number and contact in order to communicate delays or changes.

## Refunds

Teams that drop out prior to the deadline will be entitled to a refund, less the non-refundable deposit. Teams that drop out after the deadline will not be entitled to a refund. If the tournament is shortened due to weather, teams will be entitled to a partial refund based on number of games each team plays. Example, if no games are played, the team will be refunded entire fee minus $\$ 75.00$; if one game is played, the refund will be $50 \%$; if two or more games played, no refund will be made.

## Concession Stand

Our complex in Bridgewater has a full concession stand and indoor bathrooms. Board of health regulations prohibits the use of outdoor grills at our softball fields and playgrounds. There is absolutely NO
SMOKING or ALCOHOL allowed on premises. We respectfully ask that you respect our parks and playgrounds and clean up after yourselves. Please make sure your dugout is clean after every game.
Dogs are allowed as spectators, but not on playing fields, and need to be kept on a leash and picked up after, NO EXCEPTIONS.
