

PARKING

1. If your schedule starts on F3 or F4 park in the main lower lot. You may use the smaller upper lot if your games start on F5 or F6. The upper lot fills quickly.
2. Umpires spots for F5 and F6 are in front of the T ball field
3. Do not block any pathways. Field crews and concessions need these pathways
4. There are signs on Martin St that designate field locations for each lot.
5. If the lower lot is filled, cars may drive up the hill by the 3-tunnel hitting cage and park up there.

BATHROOMS

1. There are full bathrooms in the lower area F1-F4 fields as well as Porta-Johns.
2. The upper lot F5 and F6 only have Porta-Johns

CONCESSIONS

1. Lower parking F3 & F4 have full concessions
2. Upper parking F5 & F6 have full concessions

Menu : hamburgers, hot dogs, french fries, onion rings, mozzarella sticks, chicken sandwiches, chicken tenders

Candy, candy bars, ice cream, freeze pops
Popcorn, mac-n-cheese, seeds

Coffee, soda, water, gatorade, ice tea, hot chocolate, hot tea

TRASH

1. One big dumpster in the lower lot
2. At least 2 trash bins per field. You may bag your own trash if you picnic and leave by a pathway and our crew will pick it up. Please be neat.
3. No sunflower seeds on the fields. (Coaches please follow this rule)
4. Coaches must make sure each dugout is clear of all trash after each game

FIELD CREW AND MAINTENANCE

1. We strive and succeed in a full field prep prior to each game. Please give our crew room to work between games.
2. With 30 minute gaps between games, there will be no infield warmups prior to games.

SMOKING

1. You may smoke in the parking areas
2. Please be respectful to all our guests in regards to smoking

ALCOHOL

1. No alcohol allowed on the complex

PRE-GAME HITTING

1. NO HITTING NETS INSIDE THE FIELD FENCES. THIS IS ONE RULE WE MUST ENFORCE. HITTING AT A NET DESTROYS THE FIELD GRASS. USE THE HITTING NETS OUTSIDE THE FENCES AWAY FROM SPECTATORS
2. F3 HAS ITS OWN HITTING CAGE
3. F4 HAS HITTING CAGE ACCESS ON F1 CAGE
4. THERE IS A 3-BAY HITTING CAGE UP THE HILL AT THE END OF THE MAIN LOT. TEAMS MAY ONLY OCCUPY ONE BAY AT A TIME

PRE-GAME WARMUP

1. Teams may use the T-ball field
2. Teams may use the outfield of their game field
3. If F1 and F2 are open (baseball) you may use those OUTFIELDS ONLY
4. There is an opening up by the 3 bay hitting cages that may be used for throwing.

FIRST-AID

1. We have ice packs at each concession stand
2. Teams are responsible for their own first aid

NO OPEN GRILLING ALLOWED NO DOGS (Liability issue)

SCORES

1. Both coaches must report matching scores to F5/F6 concession area
2. Both coaches please text scores to 508-838-8746 ASAP after your games
3. Updates will be done as scores come in
4. Bracket for Sunday will be available by 8pm on Saturday
5. On Sunday you either start your day at 8am or 10am.

TROPHY

1. TEAM TROPHIES ARE AWARDED FOR 1ST AND 2ND
2. PLAYER T-SHIRTS ARE AWARDED INSTEAD OF TROPHIES

GAME BALLS

1. 2 new game balls will be made available to the umpires prior to each game
2. Return all used game balls to F5/F6 concessions
3. Teams may keep any over the fence HR balls

T-SHIRTS

1. Pre-orders will be available by 9am on SATURDAY at the latest
2. They will be boxed by team name
3. Send one team representative to pick up and pay for your order if it has not been pre-paid

UMPIRES

1. Pay at the plate pre-game
2. 80\$ each umpire split, by teams. 2 umpires each game.
3. RYBSA pays for the championships game umpires, 2 umpires minimally
4. Umpires will settle ALL on field disputes.
5. Umpires may eject coaches, players or fans

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Tournament rules are set for the by USA Softball Massachusetts
2. RYBSA has no rules of its own as far as games and person behavior are concerned
3. Rules are standardized for all tournaments in Massachusetts
4. This is a class B Massachusetts tournament.
5. See USA Softball Massachusetts for rules
6. Pool games may end in a tie
7. International tie-breaker is used for bracket games
8. NO TIME limit in the championship game, full 7 innings unless a mercy
9. 90-minute no new inning starts rule is in play for all other games including semis
10. Standard USA Softball mercy rules apply to all games, no run limits
